Volunteer Position: Home Repair Volunteer

Position Summary: Home Repair Volunteers work on homes to perform home repair projects that have met the qualifications for the Home Repair Program. Volunteers will work closely with the Home Repair Project Manager to ensure quality work is completed, site safety is maintained, and open communication before, during and after a project. Critical home repairs would remain incomplete without the time and leadership of the Volunteers.

Length of Commitment: Flexible

Responsibilities:

1. Maintain knowledge of the Blount County Habitat for Humanity Home Repair Program
2. Receive and review project Scope of Work before workday- provided by Home Repair Project Manager
3. Arrive at project site for homeowner introduction and site preparation/organization
4. Follow construction tasks, safety and cleanup instructions
 - Utilize the safety checklist provided by the Home Repair Project Manager
 - All tools and safety gear are provided
5. Monitor work for quality and safety
6. Dress appropriately for weather and wear protective footwear (no sandals allowed)
7. Be available to assist on heavy volunteer days as needed and according to comfort and skill level.

Qualifications or special skills needed:

1. Demonstrate adequate construction skill as determined by Home Repair Project Manager
2. Ability to work well with people from diverse backgrounds
3. Quickly build rapport with homeowners and other volunteers
4. Have a willingness to learn and help
5. Clean background and sex-offender check

Training provided:

1. Home Repair Volunteer Training- Biennially
2. Home Repair Site Safety Training- Biennially
